Lecturer in Auditory Science: Post A Lecturer in Clinical Audiology: Post B

Two lecturer posts in Audiology are offered at The Ear Institute.

The UCL Ear Institute is a multi-disciplinary facility which opened in January 2005 with the remit of "understanding hearing and fighting deafness". The Institute seeks to appoint two Lecturer posts as part of the BSc programme in Audiology, funded by the Department of Health.

Post A is primarily for an individual seeking to further their research in the field of hearing and balance as well as managing the undergraduate and postgraduate student research conducted during these taught courses in audiology. The candidate for this post would be expected to develop research proposals for funding and conduct research independently.

Post B is primarily for a clinical audiologist with considerable practical experience who now wishes to teach aspects of clinical audiology at undergraduate and postgraduate level. The candidate will be expected to develop and manage aspects of the current courses and develop course materials for new courses.

Salary for both posts: UCL Grade 8 in the range \pounds 34,943 - \pounds 41,244 inclusive of London Allowance per annum.
