

Summer Internship Program

Each summer the House Research Institute hosts a small number of students to participate in institute research programs. Students are selected based on academic performance and overall interest shown. The long-term goal of our program is to encourage students to pursue academic and career paths in biology and bioengineering. The short-term goals are to provide an educational and research experience in these disciplines as they relate to the auditory system, and to provide students with an improved understanding of scientific methods.





The internship program will focus on multiple disciplines within auditory research. All students will receive exposure and instruction in basic biology, biophysics, and bioengineering approaches in unraveling the development, structure, and mechanics of the auditory system. Based on his/her interest, each student will be paired with a mentor to pursue a research project in one of these areas. Through group discussions and collaborations, we will showcase the multidisciplinary nature of scientific investigations within the auditory system.
