Primary areas of interest are expertise in teaching and conducting translation research in the following areas: Pediatric Audiology –Assessment and / or Rehabilitation, Educational Audiology, Dual sensory / Multisensory impairments. Candidates with expertise in other areas are also encouraged to apply.

Qualifications.

- Doctoral degree in Audiology
- Experience in effective University teaching methods
- Hold or be eligible for PA audiology Licensure
- Knowledge and expertise in the clinical practice of pediatric audiology
- Show evidence of research activity and interest in translational research

We encourage applicants from all areas of expertise in Audiology. Preference will be given to candidates with expertise in Pediatric audiology and with 5 years plus experience in University teaching and clinical experience. Prior university service experience is highly desirable. National recognition in the area of the candidate's expertise is also highly desirable.

Primary Responsibilities: Teaching Au.D level courses: With a focus in pediatric audiology, engaging in student clinical training. Develop pediatric audiology experience within Pennsylvania Ear Institute (PEI) for the students. Conduct and disseminate scholarly translational research in pediatric audiology or in the candidate's area of expertise. Participate in College and University service activities.
