DeSForM - the conference on Design and Semantics of Form and Movement - has traditionally dealt with the design of new, dynamic, and interactive artifacts supported by the rise of intelligent systems.

In this edition, we challenge scholars to think beyond single artifacts with embedded intelligence, and to start addressing the distributed, hyperconnected, and complex ecosystems that will form the landscape for future intelligences. Designers should begin to consider not just algorithmic thinking and functionality, but how meaning, experience, and ethics can be addressed in these new systems.
