## Overview:

Boys Town National Research Hospital is an open-rank Research Scientist in the Center for Hearing Research. Scientists are full-time researchers with no teaching responsibilities. Administrative and service commitment are reasonable. Candidates from traditionally underrepresented backgrounds are especially encouraged to apply. The position is not limited to a specific research focus, but applicants in the following areas are encouraged to apply:

- Spatial hearing
- Amplification
- Auditory and/or speech perception across the lifespan

## **Benefits of Being a Research Scientist:**

- Access to state-of-the art laboratory facilities, generous start-up funds, extensive support for grant management, IT, participant recruitment, and clinical measurement
- Senior scientists aim for 50% salary support on external grants.
- Junior scientists are provided with extensive mentoring and three years of full support to enable them to reach this goal.
- Collaborations are possible with faculty in the following Centers: (1) Childhood Deafness, Language, and Learning; (2) Human Neurosciences; (3) Neurobehavioral Research; (4) Sensory Neuroscience Research, and (4) Audiological and Vestibular Services.
- The intellectual community also includes colleagues at the University of Nebraska-Omaha, the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, the University of Nebraska Medical Center, Creighton University, and the Creighton University School of Medicine.

## Qualifications:

- A successful candidate will have a Ph.D. in Hearing Science, Engineering, Audiology, Speech-Language Pathology, Cognitive Science, Developmental Psychology, Experimental Psychology or a related field.
- A record that demonstrates a highly productive and excellent research program, with the potential to attract and obtain external funding, is required.
- Post-doctoral training and/or or faculty-level experience is preferred, but not required.
